

# Activity: Right or Privilege?

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- ✓ Group participants in the middle of the room.
- ✓ On the right side of room post the word “**Right.**”
- ✓ On the left side of the room post the word “**Privilege.**”
- ✓ As statements are read, participants will walk either right or left.
- ✓ Once in place, participants will discuss why they are standing where they are.
- ✓ Participants will then return to the center of the room to await the next statement.

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- ✓ There is a distinction between personal rights, rights of groups, and rights of nations.
- ✓ Rights issues are complex and are often taken to court.
- ✓ Courts have tended to rule in favor of Tribal rights.
- ✓ The binding, legal agreements between Tribes and the Federal Government establish **why** there is a distinction between Indians and other racial/ethnic groups.
